Parking for Packet Pickup Saturday and Race Day Sunday is indicated on the map.

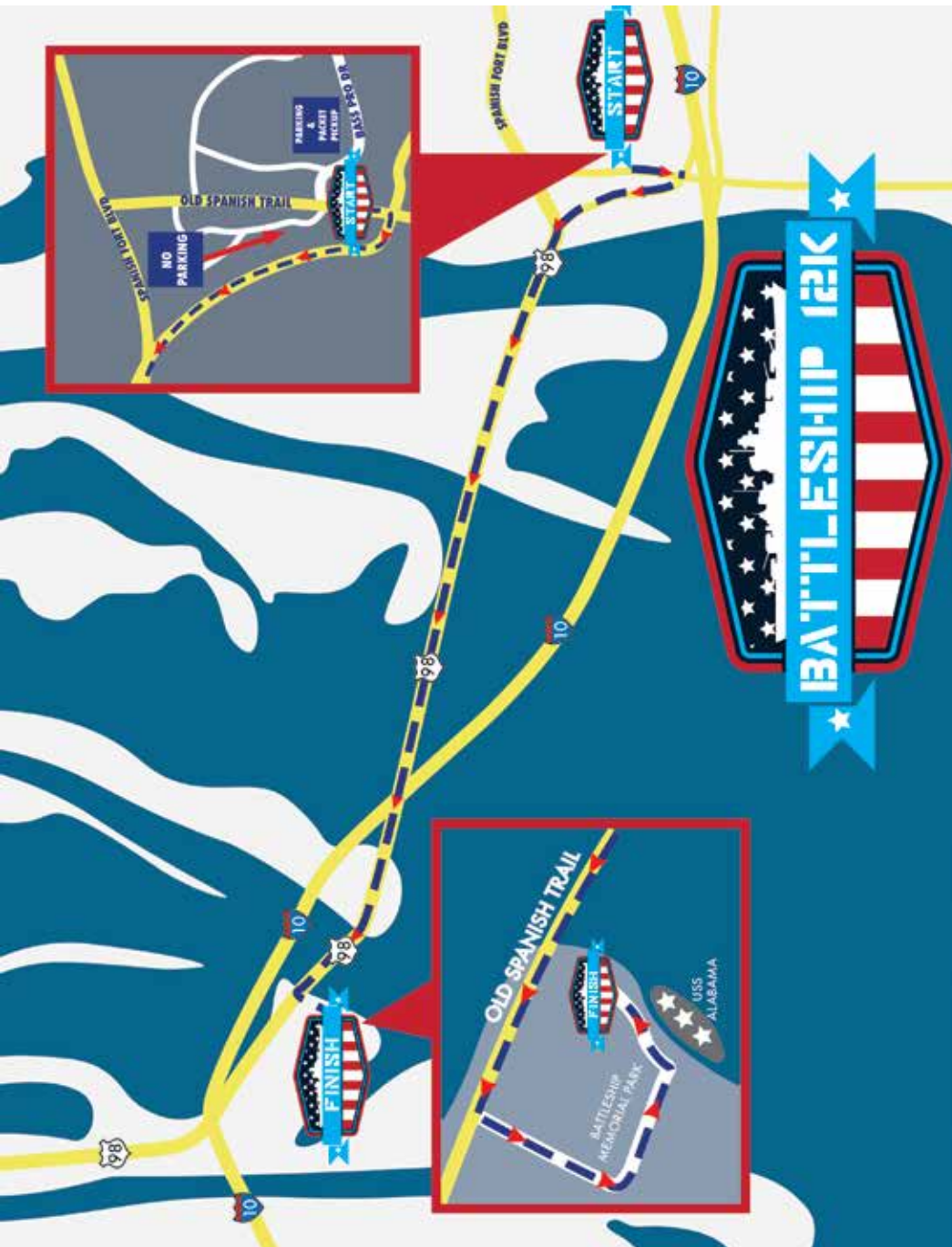
PACKET PICK UP INFORMATION

Every participant in the event will receive a confirmation email with your race bib number. Please bring your bib number and a photo ID with you to pick up your packet. Participants will be picking up their bibs by their assigned bib number instead of last name so be sure to look for the email with your bib number. We will also have a large sign with everyone's name and bib number on it at packet pickup in case you need to look up your bib number again.

You CAN pick up bibs for other participants. In order to do this you MUST HAVE a copy of their photo ID OR a copy of their registration confirmation, as well as their bib number. Digital copies (your cell phone screen) are allowed. This can ONLY BE DONE on Saturday.

POST RACE & AWARDS

The BATTLESHIP 12K is a Patriotic Run to Honor those who have served. To honor our military we have to know who they are. If you see a Red bib be sure to thank those men and women for their service.

This race is being scored utilizing MyLaps BibTag technology. Your timing tag is on the back of your bib. Please do not fold, bend or remove it.

Awards will be presented to the Top 3 Overall M/F, Overall Master winner (M/F 40+), Overall Grand Master winner (M/F 50+), overall Senior Grand Master winner (M/F 60+), Top 3 M/F Military, and the top three M/F of each age group.

Age groups are as follows: 14 & under, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70 and over. Overall awards are decided based on gun time, age group awards are decided based on participant's chip time. Awards need to be claimed at Battleship Memorial Park.

Alumni runners (2018 finishers) will receive their Challenge Coin during Packet Pick Up on Saturday. If you opted to have your packet mailed to you, the coin can be claimed after the race.
